

Admission Information Handout

Bachelor of Science in Agriculture (Honours) Batch – 2021.

1) Important Dates

- 1.1. Starting date for Registration : **Thursday, 18th March 2021**
1.2. Last date for Application / Registration : **Thursday, 30th Sep., 2021**

2) Duration of the course : Four (4) Years

3) Student Intake : 60

4) Eligibility Criteria (fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory)

- 4.1 A candidate must have passed 10+2 or Equivalent Examination and must have obtained a minimum of **50 % Aggregate Marks** with PCM/PCB/PCMB (P- Physics, C- Chemistry, M-Mathematics, B-Biology) from a recognized Board/ University.
- 4.2 A candidate who has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from IB Board should be either IB certificate or DP awarded with total of minimum 24 credits having passed 3 HL & 3 SL mandatorily from any stream.
- 4.3 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they meet minimum cut-off marks and should be eligible & produce all the necessary documents, in original, at the time of admission.
- 4.4 Candidate of CBSE & ICSE should mention in the Registration Form (if selected), 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s.
- 4.5 In case mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects taken & appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 4.6 **Instructions for IB & Cambridge Candidates:** Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given “**Provisional Admission**” based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate, but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet, before the commencement of the programme.

Marksheet/Transcripts issued by Board/ University only be considered (School/Institute will not be accepted.)

- 4.7 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas University / College.
- 4.8 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board / University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA/ CGPA obtained.
- 4.9 Candidates above **25 years** of age are not eligible to apply.
- 4.10 Only Single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed will be considered. Compartmentalized mark sheet will not be considered.
- 4.11 In any stage if it is found that, the 10 + 2 marks given by candidate in **Application Form** is different from marks actually obtained (as per mark sheet) such candidate admission will be Cancelled & Fees will be forfeited.
- 4.12 Candidate whose Final Mark Sheet is not available at the time of Admission are required to upload internet copy of result or Digi locker copy of result, duly attested by Principal of the school/ college, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program.
- 4.13 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as Ungraded / Fail in the marksheet / grade sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be considered as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.
- 4.14 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.

5) Online Registration & Payment of Registration:

Online Registration Fee of Rs. 1200 /- plus applicable taxes (Please refer online registration for payment details.)

Registration Fee is non-refundable.

6) Selection Process

1. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 12th Aggregate Percentage provided by the candidate at the time of registration.
2. The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

3. Once the merit list is declared, candidate has to login to check result on NMIMS portal using his / her credentials. If selected, candidate has to accept or reject the offer. If offer is accepted, then candidate has to upload all the documents mentioned in the admission offer letter using the link given in admission offer letter.

7) Program Fees: (Subject to change)

- Program fees for 1st year B.Sc. Agriculture (Hons.) Batch–2020 was Rs.1,15,000/- per annum
- Program fees for 1st year B.Sc. Agriculture (Hons.) Batch–2021 will be announced at the time of admission.

- 8) **Refund Rules:** If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission (on or before 20th Oct., 2021)
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission (i.e., from 21st Oct., 2021 to 5th Nov., 2021)
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission (i.e., from 6th Nov., 2021 to 20th Nov., 2021)
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, After Formally-Notified Last Date of Admission (i.e., 21st Nov., 2021 to 5th Dec., 2021)
5	00%	More than 30 days after Formally-Notified Last Date of Admission (i.e., after 6th Dec., 2021)

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

9) Important instructions:

- For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal /cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate should email at admissioncancellation@nmims.edu, the soft copy of admission cancellation form duly filled and signed (form available on <https://www.nmims.edu/students/>, fee paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account).
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide.

- All announcements from the institute will be through its website: www.agriculture.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidates.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether he / she is eligible for the respective Program as per the eligibility criteria stated above.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected, will stand cancelled.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given.
