**Refund Rules:** The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule October 2018: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
1	100%	15 days or more before the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission <b>(on or before Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> October 2020)</b>
2	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission <b>(i.e., from 13<sup>th</sup> October 2020 to 28<sup>th</sup> October 2020)</b>
3	80%	15 days or less after the formally-Notified Last Date of Admission <b>(i.e., from 29<sup>th</sup> October 2020 to 12<sup>th</sup> November 2020)</b>
4	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, After Formally-Notified Last Date of Admission <b>(i.e., 13<sup>th</sup> November 2020 to 27<sup>th</sup> November 2020)</b>
5	00%	More than 30 days after Formally-Notified Last Date of Admission <b>(i.e., after 28<sup>th</sup> November 2020 onwards)</b>

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

**1) Important Dates**

**Starting date for Registration : Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> March 2020**  
**Last date for Application / Registration : Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

**2) Duration of the course : Four (4) Years**

**3) Student Intake for B.Sc. (Ag.) Program : 60**

**4) Eligibility Criteria (fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory)**

- 4.1 A candidate must have passed 10+2 or Equivalent Examination and must have obtained a minimum of **60% Aggregate Marks** with PCB (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) subjects at their 10+2 or Equivalent Examination.
- 4.2 A candidate who has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from IB Board should be either IB certificate or DP awarded with 24 credits compulsory, having passed 3 HL with minimum (12 credits) & 3 SL with minimum (9 credits) mandatorily from any stream.
- 4.3 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they meet minimum cut-off marks and should be eligible & produce all the necessary documents, in original, at the time of admission.
- 4.4 Candidate of CBSE & ICSE should mention in the Registration Form (if selected), 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s.
- 4.5 In case mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects taken & appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program.
- 4.6 **Instructions for IB & Cambridge Candidates:** Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given “**Provisional Admission**” based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate, but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet, before the commencement of the programme.  
Marksheet/Transcripts issued by Board/ University only be considered (School/Institute will not be accepted.)
- 4.7 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas University / College.

- 4.8 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board / University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA/ CGPA obtained.
- 4.9 Candidates above **25 years** of age are not eligible to apply.
- 4.10 Single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in **one attempt** is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet will be considered.
- 4.11 In any stage if it is found that, the 10 + 2 marks given by candidate in **Application Form** is different from marks actually obtained (as per mark sheet) such candidate admission will be Cancelled & Fees will be forfeited.
- 4.12 Candidate whose Final Mark Sheet is not available at the time of Admission are required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the School / College with official seal, failing which candidate will not be admitted for the program.
- 4.13 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as Ungraded / Fail in the marksheet / grade sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be considered as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.
- 4.14 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.

**6) Selection Process**

1. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 12<sup>th</sup> Aggregate Percentage provided by the candidate at the time of registration.
2. The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
3. Once the merit list is declared, candidate has to login to check result on NMIMS portal using his / her credentials. If selected, candidate has to accept or reject the offer. If, offer is accepted, then candidate has to upload all the documents mentioned in the admission offer letter using the link given in admission offer letter.
